Why Be Involved?

Although the program focuses on picking up litter, you can also participate in additional projects. These projects would need to be reviewed, but include such things as cutting back the vegetation or removing graffiti. A litter-free community is satisfying to residents. By helping keep our river and levee attractive and free of litter everyone who participates feels ownership and a sense of pride in the community.

- Carry a cellular telephone.
- Wear gloves
- Wear appropriate footwear
- Keep a safe distance from the river when appropriate
- Stick together
- Handle hazardous material safely
