Graffiti Abatement

Pendleton City Ordinance 2775, Sections 15.06 and 16.01 requires property owners to cover up graffiti within three days of receiving written notice to abate. Failure to comply with the aforementioned Ordinance may result in a fine of \$500.

In an attempt to encourage property owners to comply with Ordinance 2775 in a timely manner, the Pendleton Police Department in partnership with Zimmerman & Co. Hardware has established an anti-graffiti program. The program is designed to share the burden of eradicating graffiti, which if ignored can promote additional criminal activity.

The program:

- Upon receiving notice to abate graffiti, property owners are asked to take this form to Zimmerman & Co. Hardware located at 348 S. Main Street, Pendleton.
- Zimmerman & Co. will allow property owners to charge the materials needed to remove graffiti from their property to the police department.
 - Approved materials may include, but are not limited to:
 - Paint
 - Brush
 - Roller
 - Pan
 - Latex gloves
 - Or;
 - Products specifically designed to remove graffiti
